Dear Parents,

These are the recent updates regarding schools to provide care for children whose parents are critical to the Covid-19 response and those who are vulnerable.

Parents critical to the Covid -19 response are:

- Health and Social Care
- Education and Childcare
- Key Public services
- Local and national government
- Food and necessary goods
- Public safety workers including police, armed forces personnel, firefighters and prison staff
- Transport
- Utilities, communication and financial services staff.

Vulnerable children include children who are supported by :

- social care
- those with safeguarding and welfare needs
- child protection plans

These groups of children will be able to attend the school from March 23rd – April the 3rd. Care will be provided from 8 am – 5pm.

1. Breakfast Club will be open at 8.00 o'clock.
2. Children on the Free Meals Register will be offered a free packed lunch which is to be collected by the parents between 11.00-12.00 o'clock.
3. Children attending school for the next fortnight can bring their own packed lunch or they can buy a packed lunch for £2.50.
